Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting that the Appropriations Committee provide a funding level of \$1,600,000 for Building Futures: Iowa's Innovative Answer to Conquering Youth Homeless. The entity to receive funding for this project is the YSS: Iowa Homeless Youth Centers (IHYC), located at 612 Locust Street, Des Moines, IA 50309. The funding investment will support the renovation of a youth homeless center in Des Moines, Iowa, to help expand its programming to increase its capacity to serve homeless youth. It will encourage homeless youth to enroll and use free academic, health, wellness, and educational community programming. This request will serve approximately 500 additional individuals over a 5-year period. Now more than ever, at-risk youth is in need of immediate, effective, and comprehensive services to address their needs. Research shows that teens at risk have increased levels of stress and mental health issues, which potentially result in poor academic performance, unwanted pregnancy, substance abuse, criminal activity, and suicide. This is a good use of taxpayer money as IHYC is the only Des Moines-are organization providing free access to a safe place for at-risk, low-income, and low-performing homeless or at-risk youth. This funding will be used for the children who need it most and create positive social investment in the well-being and futures of American citizens.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program: 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
