A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to carry out a study relating to the resiliency of Social Security and Medicare.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safeguarding Social
- 5 Security and Medicare Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds the following:

1	(1) Congress must protect the resiliency and
2	longevity of Social Security and Medicare.
3	(2) 71.7 million people receive Social Security
4	benefits and 66.6 million people receive Medicare
5	benefits.
6	(3) Medicare is critical to our elderly and dis-
7	abled population and their families.
8	(4) Social Security benefits are necessary for
9	our elderly population who already survive on limited
10	budgets.
11	(5) Seniors earn their benefits after contrib-
12	uting their payroll taxes for decades.
13	(6) American workers are contributing with the
14	promise of a financially secure future for themselves
15	and their families.
16	(7) The increased cost of living and record lev-
17	els of inflation continue to put a financial strain on
18	every American, especially those on Social Security
19	and Medicare.
20	(8) It is necessary to carry out a study to un-
21	derstand how cost of living and inflation projections
22	will affect Social Security and Medicare and to pro-
23	vide recommendations to Congress.

1 SEC. 3. STUDY ON SOCIAL SECURITY AND MEDICARE.

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment 3 of this Act, the Comptroller General shall conduct a study 4 and submit a report to Congress on the following: (1) The effect of inflation and cost of living in-5 creases on Medicare and the Old-Age Survivor and 6 7 Disability Insurance program under title II of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.). 8 9 (2) Recommendations on any legislative actions necessary to improve the ability to provide full bene-10 11 fits under such programs.
