
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting that the Appropriations Committee provide a funding level of \$2,000,000 for the IA Highway 141/NW Towner Drive Interchange project as a Community Project Funding request for Fiscal Year 2026. The recipient for this project is the City of Johnston, IA, located at 6221 Merle Hay Road, Box 410, Johnston, IA 50131. The funding would be used to construct a grade separated interchange, a roundabout interchange configuration, and improvements to IA Highway 141. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve safety within the high-speed transitional facility feeding the northwest part of the Des Moines metropolitan area.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
